KRE Organizational and Operating Regulations,

Appendix No. II. 2., 11/A. §

The Senate may grant the title of Honorary Citizen of the University to a natural person who does not have an employment or other employment relationship with the University, or who does not receive benefits under any other legal title, who has made an outstanding contribution to the promotion of the University's educational, research and cultural tasks with his support, activities, and behavior representing the interests of the University, to improve the domestic and international recognition of the institution.

The holder of the title is entitled to use the title "Citizen of Honor of the Károli Gáspár University of the Reformed Church in Hungary".
