- You will get an introduction to the language/concept of education.
- We will discuss how the artform of film enacts education.

- These will be short preparatory readings about film conventions, introductions to the films we watch and readings about the concept of pedagogy (or education)

Application Criteria:

- Be enrolled on an undergraduate course in any discipline.
- Be willing to work collaboratively.
